Pine Mountain Lake Airport Improvements

Several of our Chapter members worked to facilitate some badly needed maintenance at the Pine Mountain Lake Airport. The work completed included the filling of hundreds of cracks in the runway, taxiway and ramp pavement and the repair of several drainage structures. These repairs will help preserve the pavement by keeping

water out of the pavement sub-grade and will also reduce the hazards to an aircraft that inadvertently departs the runway or taxiway.
